

# Arizona District Junior Bible Quiz Sportsmanship Program

1. The purpose of the sportsmanship program is to encourage and reward Christ-like behavior in Bible Quiz competition. Throughout the season, points will be awarded for sportsmanship. Teams attaining the highest level of sportsmanship will earn a special sportsmanship award.
2. Points will be awarded to each team at the conclusion of each quiz match. The scoring will be from 1-5 in each of two categories. The categories are: **Conduct of Quizzers**, and **Conduct of Coaches**.

**1 - poor**

**2 -**

**3 - average**

**4 –** (*shaking hands after the match*)

**5 - outstanding** (*the team or coach show a Christ-like character in handling a difficult situation*)

There can be a score of 40 points maximum (4 officials per room fill out the forms) per quiz round given by the quizmaster and officials (don't use the scorekeeper because he/she is busy tallying the score). They are to use their judgment in awarding points and should fill out the form after the teams have left the room or the score has been read. Each league, five quiz rounds will count toward sportsmanship points. If a team quizzes more rounds, the five highest scores will count (drop the lowest scores). This gives a maximum of 200 points per league for Conduct.

3. In addition, every team must provide two officials per league. Your team receives 10 points per league match for providing your officials. If you bring only one, you will receive only 5 points. If your church has more than two teams, each additional team needs only to bring one official per team to receive their 10 points ( i.e. a church with 3 teams would need 5 officials, a church with 4 teams would need 6 officials, etc.). Each team can also earn 5 bonus points for bringing extra officials. A team can only receive a maximum of 15 points per league for officials regardless of how many officials they bring, however, any extra officials are greatly appreciated. This gives a maximum of 215 sportsmanship points per league.

We have been using this program in Arizona for the last 4 years. In that time, we have seen a great improvement in attitudes of coaches, quizzers, and officials. We have also gone from not having enough officials to having 4-5 officials per room. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
